Bark Park Rules

Bark til Dark

Dogs must remain leashed to and from the Bark Park

BEFORE ENTERING THIS PARK, ALL INDIVIDUALS MUST READ AND AGREE TO THE FOLLOWING RULES AND CONDITIONS:

1. Picerne Military Housing assumes no responsibility or liability for injury or damage caused by the use of this facility.
2. Use of this park is for Picerne Military Housing residents only and at your own risk.
3. Owners are legally responsible for the actions of their dogs and injuries caused by them.
4. Owners must clean up and properly dispose of dog waste and immediately fill any holes their dog(s) dig.
5. Dogs must never be left unattended.
6. Dogs are the only type of animals allowed in the park.
7. Aggressive dogs are not allowed.
8. No more than three (3) dogs per visitor.
9. All dogs must wear a collar with current tags.
10. All dogs must be properly licensed, registered, healthy and have current vaccinations within code or post regulations.
11. No puppies younger than 16 weeks are allowed.
12. No dogs in heat are allowed.
13. Dogs that bark continually should be muzzled or removed.
14. Owners should be aware of their dog's behavior and move to another area of the park if requested by another visitor.
15. You must remove your dog's pronged collar before you enter the dog park.
16. The small dog enclosure is for dogs under 20 pounds.
17. Both gates must be closed and latched after entering or exiting the area.
18. No children under the age of 14 without close adult supervision.
19. The only food of any kind permitted is bite-sized dog treats.
20. Do not give dogs treats without the owner's permission.
21. Benches are for people.
22. The park may be closed at times for maintenance.
23. Serious problems resulting in injury must be reported immediately.
